Please do not report any buildings, including those boarded up, abandoned, or similar structures where people congregate overnight. These are **NOT** considered a targeted nonsheeltered outdoor location.

DO include pre-designated or adhoc sites with car and/or RV and/or tent encampments where people stay overnight without paying.

DO NOT include established campgrounds or RV parks where people most often are required to pay. These campgrounds and RV parks will be counted in another Census operation.
